FEBRUARY PROGRAM: DEMONSTRATION OF CONTOURING - The tree, a Crepe Myrtle, belonging to Darryl, was recently removed, by him, from his yard. It was cut straight across just above the trunk prior to being removed from the earth. The contouring done by Jason, helps to create a smoother transition to grow around the tree as it is developing. Contouring also allows water to run off the flat surfaced, thereby helping to eliminate wood rot. After the initial contouring steps were taken, Darryl applied a lysol solution to inhibit fungus on the large wound that needs to heal over. (Refer to pictures on our website.)
