Workshops

Exhibit Program and Critique – William N. Valavanis and Sean Smith

This interactive program is paid for with your full registration or your Friday night single registration. Ted and Sean will discuss techniques for effective shohin bonsai display, as well as effective flow and direction. This is a not to be missed event!

Workshop I – Crape Myrtle – William N. Valavanis \$100

Eight (8) Participants – Bill loves Crape Myrtles and we have a wonderful variety of dwarf species for you. These trees have been grown as pre-bonsai for more than three years and are going to be beautiful small trees with tiny leaves, great twigging and mixed colors. They will be ready for repotting and you will walk away with a beautiful bonsai, so bring your potting soil and choose a pot from one of our great vendors.

Workshop II – Olive – Ted Matson \$135

Six (6) Participants – These Olives have been sent from a premier olive grower in California and are beautiful small-leafed Shohin-size trees with nice fat trunks, ready for repotting at the time of this workshop. Learn from our Olive expert, Ted who along with being a Shohin presented from the California Shohin Society. Bring your soil if you plan on reporting these trees during this workshop.

Workshop III – Figure Stone & Daiza Carving – Sean Smith \$95

Eight (8) Participants – Sean will bring figure stones to work with so each person will leave with one Shohin-sized figure stone and daiza. This will be the first time Sean presents this workshop, so be sure to sign up early for this exciting event. All participants must bring a Dremel® tool and safety glasses for this workshop.

Workshop IV – Twisted Pomegranate – Ted Matson \$100/\$150/\$185

Seven (7) Participants – Pomegranates are one of Ted's specialties and these are beautiful trees that were locally grown and ready to be worked on as bonsai. We have 2–Shohin at \$100; 3–Gifu at \$150 and 2–Chuhin at \$185 available for this workshop. Ted will explain how to grow, design and work on these during his workshop. This is a limited workshop, so register early. Prices will vary according to tree selection.

Workshop V – Root Stand Carving – Sean Smith \$95

Eight (8) Participants – Sean will teach you how to make a beautiful root stand for your next display. You will be carving and working on beautiful shohin-size stand. All participants must bring a Dremel® tool and safety glasses for this workshop.

Exhibit Critique – Ted Matson \$15

This critique is limited to twenty (20) participants and will be a discussion and analysis of the exhibit trees by our speaker. Ted will offer in-depth analysis of select trees.
